

Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) Evaluation

What UCP Needs to Get You Started ☐ Speech-language Therapy evaluation report and most recent speech-language therapy progress report. ☐ DDD Planning documents: Individual Service Plan (ISP) for school-age children, o or Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) for children up to age 3 A copy of the family or child's primary insurance and/or Medicaid card. Provide a copy of BOTH sides of the card. A prescription for an AAC evaluation from the referring physician with the name and contact information of the physician. The physician should have seen your child in the last 6 months. ☐ UCP AAC Intake Packet □ DDD AAC Referral Packet or UCP AAC Pre-Assessment Review Form What Optional Items Needed Prior to a UCP AAC Evaluation, if applicable ☐ Individualized Education Programs (IEP) and Multidisciplinary Evaluation (MET) reports ☐ Results of a vision screening or test ☐ Results of a hearing screening or test ☐ Reports from any psychological (cognitive) testing

Additional equipment needed (e.g., cervical collar, hand braces, AFOs), if applicable
Previous or current AAC devices, if applicable

What to Expect During a UCP AAC Evaluation

Families are an important part of the AAC team. During the evaluation, the UCP AAC team will:

- Talk to you about your child's current communication abilities and needs
- Learn about what motivates your child
- Do fun context-based activities that apply to real life while trying a variety of AAC tools preprogrammed for that activity
- Obtain consent to communicate with your child's teachers, therapy providers, etc. to learn more about how your child is communicating in other environments
- Complete paperwork related to AAC device ordering
